**Part A**

**The Plan of Action**

In the beginning of the year 2006-2007 the IQAC committee with the proper guidance of the Principal prepared action plan considering the following points.

- 1) It was decided to follow up the feedback mechanism for various teaching programmes as well as well as receive feedback from the outgoing students.
- 2) It was decided to hold frequent discussions with parents and students to maintain quality in the progress of students.
- 3) To continue certificate courses run under Adult Education scheme, environment awareness and health education.
- 4) The committee decided to conduct various programmes in the institution for cultural, social, intellectual, moral, physical development and enhancement of students.
- 5) The committee decided to inspire the faculty members for continuing research activities.
- 6) It was decided to provide special attention towards the students weak at particular subjects.
- 7) It was also decided to conduct various programmes related with community services.
- 8) To facilitate the students with financial assistance through various schemes of the University.
- 9) To update the available infrastructure of the institution.
- 10) It was decided to perform all official work computerised.
- 11) To hold the library transactions computerised.

## **Part B**

### **Activities reflecting the Goals and Objectives of the Institution**

- 1) The following measures were taken for the social, rational, moral and educational development of the students.
  - a) Backward students were provided with remedial coaching and special guidance was provided to the topper students.
  - b) Lectures by eminent and popular persons were conducted for overall development of the students.
- 2) N.S.S. Camp was arranged to inculcate self discipline and accountability in the students as well as to develop national integrity and unity amongst them.
- 3) With the view of providing equal opportunity of education and developing overall personality of the students -
  - a) Interactive method of teaching in which students were inspired to ask questions, was conducted.
  - b) Group discussions among students were inspired.
  - c) Seminars were arranged.
- 4) To achieve community and social development by utilizing infrastructure facilities -
  - a) Lectures of various eminent personality and various cultural programmes with assistance of alumni were arranged.
  - b) The auditorium and the Seminar Hall and the play ground are utilized by society for conducting social meetings and other programmes.

### **Examination Activities :-**

Annual Examinations for UG level; and the semester examination for B.C.M. & M.C.M. are conducted by Dr. B.A.M.Univeristy, Aurangabad. The college has conducted class Tests, Tutorials and first terminal examinations as per the academicdiary of 2006-2007. The particular students poor at the specific subjects were given special attention for their further preparation. Extra lectures were held by the respective teachers for the weaker students.

### **Research Activities :-**

- \* During this year Mr. Khakre P. R. (Head, Department of Chemistry) was registered for Ph. D. And Mr. Dongare A. K. Registered for M.Phil.
- \* Mr. Shelke A. N. (Head, Department of Zoology) published paper in National workshop on Recent trends in Biotech organised by Dept. of Zoology, Lal Bahadur Shastri College Satara on 28, 29 March 2007.
- \* Mr. Kshirsagar S. V. (Head, Department of Physics) published a paper in National conference on Current Trends in Material Research for Advanced Technology (NCMRAT - 2007) from 29th to 31st January 2007 at Dr. B.A.M.University Aurangabad.

### **Community Services :-**

Community Services are primely conducted through N.S.S. unit, Adult Education and Earn & Learn Scheme, Savitribai Phule Student Adoption Scheme and Blood group detection and blood donation committee. During this acedamic year the college has made contribution through the following community Services.

- 1) In the month of June & July during the admission period the blood group detection & blood donation committee detected the blood groups of 1335 students. The above number of students are admitted to entry level classes. The committee also lead blood donation camp. arranged on 7th december in which 65 students and staff members as well as citizens donated blood on occassion of biirthday of honourable Shri. Jayadattaji Kishirsagar, the president of institution.

The directory of the names of blood doners was published and circulated through various social organizations of the town so that they can approach the specified blood doner in an emergency.

- 2) N.S.S. Unit of the college has arranged a youth camp at Nalwandi in which 85 boys & 41 girls contributed in cleaning campaign, road repairs, plantation, as well as digging of 20 soak pits.

The compaign of personal cleanliness and hygene was also conducted through which the villagers were frequently visited and educated by the volenteers.

- 3) Earn and learn Scheme enrolled 83 students during the year. The students participated in the production of chalk and candles. The Committee inspires the students towards self employment. The students also participated in the grass irradiation campaign conducted in the college campus and the campus of rural hospital in Patoda.

### **Teaching and non teaching ratio :-**

In the institution 39 teaching staff and 42 non teaching staff is working. The ratio is approximately 1 : 1.

### **Improvement in the library services :-**

- \* The Library is computerised and well furnished.
- \* During the academic year 412 books were purchased and cost of purchase was Rs. 79,018/-

### **Sports Activities :-**

- \* The students of institution vigorously participated in a variety of sport activities. During this academic year 12 students participated in Inter collegiate Kabaddi Competition. 7 players in state level Kabaddi Competition, 2 players were selected for University level. Kabaddi competition, 2 players were selected for University level, 02 were selected in University's Ashwamedha Competition and 02 players participated in National level Kabaddi sports meet.
- \* 12 students participated in inter-collegiate Kho-Kho Competitions, 09 in state level, 02 in inter university, 02 in Ashwamedha, 01 at National Level Kho-kho competition.
- \* During the same year 02 students participated in inter-collegiate Wrestling competition, 02 in state level, 01 in inter university and 01 in National level wrestling competition.
- \* During the same year 01 student of our institute participated in intercollegiate Boxing and 01 student in inter Universities Boxing competition.
- \* In the Running competition of inter-collegiate level 04 players gave their excellent performance.

## **Other Highlights :-**

- \* 40 Students of the institution appeared for interview for apprenticeship at Mahindra & Mahindra at Pune. 12 students were selected as a machine operator.
- \* Women Empowerment committees of the institution in collaboration with “Manavlok Sanstha, Ambejogai” arranged a one day camp on Literacy campaign on Laws for women.
- \* A students - Teachers - Parents gathering was arranged on 15/09/2006.
- \* On 15th Aug 2006 our Savitribai Phule Adoption scheme committee distributed educational stationary to economically backward 42 girls of the institution.
- \* Science, Commerce and Literary Forum of the institution published educational and informative wall- papers on 15th Aug. 17 Sept. 2006, 26th Jan and 28th Feb. 2007.
- \* On 11th Jan. 2007 Health & AIDS awareness committee arranged the Lecture on diseases from mosquito bite.
- \* AIDS awareness campaign was arranged in the institution on World AIDS day.
- \* Sewing training centre arranged a training of “Pico and Fall” and a three day camp of embroidery training in which 68 girls and women participated.
- \* Adult Education committee conducted a survey of Literacy in Patoda Taluka in July 2008. The report of which was published. In collaboration with “Pratham Sanstha Mumbai”, committee conducted a campaign of Arithmetic reading at primary classes in Patoda Taluka.

A one day Voter Awareness camp was arranged in which Dr. Kisanrao Dhabe (Dr. B.A.M.U. Aurangabad) delivered his precious guidance.
- \* Department of Marathi arranged a special exhibition of “Ancient Manuscripts”. on the occasion of annual gathering.
- \* Department of Home Science arranged Tie and Die training camp in which 13 students participated. On occasion of world AIDS Day, Rangoli Competition was arranged in which 35 students participated. The Dept. also celebrated Nutrition Week. A flower carpet training was conducted by the department.
- \* Dept of Botany arranged one day study tour at Domari village to study the diversity of plants and environmental education.
