

#### ABSTRACT:

#### INTRODUCTION

Reading is primarily and intellectual activity and reading habit is a sort of attribute of human being. Like other habits the habit of reading in an individual develops during the course of time. Psychologically, habit is product of learning; however reading is an art of interpreting the printed tools and written words. It is important for the professional staff of a library to know about the reading habit and information needs of the clientele being served.

Reading habit has been an area of active interest among the librarians and information scientists. It results from the reorganization of some need perceived by the user, who as a consequence makes demand upon formal system such as libraries, information centers of other persons in order to satisfy the perceived need.

#### BENEFIT OF READING

The impact of reading in people's lives is extraordinary wide spread. A reader can learn new skills can be introduced to new facts he can gain more knowledge about the whole world and can be stimulated to both thought and emotion. Reading has the unique power of transforming readers. #### REVIEW OF LITERATURE

Smith and Robinson defined reading as ," an active attempt on the part of reader to understand a writer's message." Reading is primarily an intellectual activity and its practice is influenced by many factors like home environment, subject, background, age, status etc. Reading helps in the resolution or personal need and in the attainment of mental maturity and independence of thought. Devarajan defines reading as an art of interpreting printed and written word. It is a tool of education and one of the most important skills in everyday life.

*Gray S.* indicates that reading influences the extent and accuracy of information as well as attitude, moral belief, judgment and action of the reader. The reading habit has one of the most powerful lasting influences in the promotions of one's personal. *Bryan* relates the reading habits in relation to the library and mentions that the librarian's task is to find the *right book for the right reader* at the right time. A librarian must know his books, he must know his reader and he must know that effect will be produced by bringing the two together

The present article is a questionnaire based study of the reading habits of students in Vasant Dada Patil College, Patoda. In order to carry out the study, a questionnaire was designed for the students of Vasant Dada Patil College, Patoda. The reading habit of student with respect to their requirements, psychological needs etc. have been studied.

#### METHODOLOGY

For the purpose of the study a questionnaire was designed and distributed among the respondents. The study was limited to find the reading habit of students in Vasant Dada Patil College, Patoda affiliated to BAMU Aurangabad. The data analysis and interpretation is based on a sample of 90 randomly selected respondents out of three categories viz. junior student, Senior Student and Post Graduate students. The branches in Vasant Dada Patil College include Arts, Science and Commerce.
